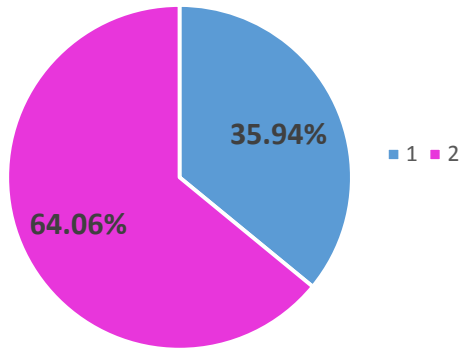

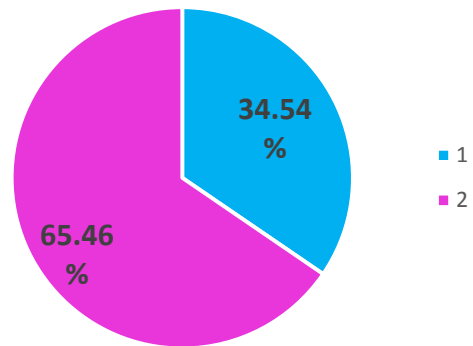
Why did you choose the course?



The option 1 in the above pie chart was degree requirement and 2 is personal Interest. Majority of the candidates, a little over 64% have chosen the course out of personal interest.

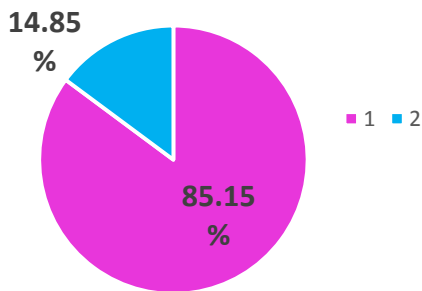

Are you satisfied by the mode being used?



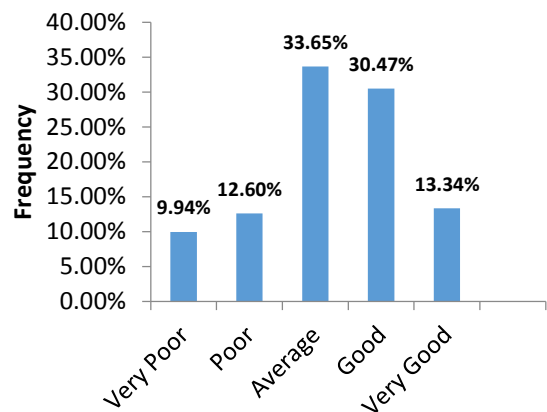
Over 65% students are satisfied with the mode of teaching used.

Level of effort invested in teaching in online mode by teachers

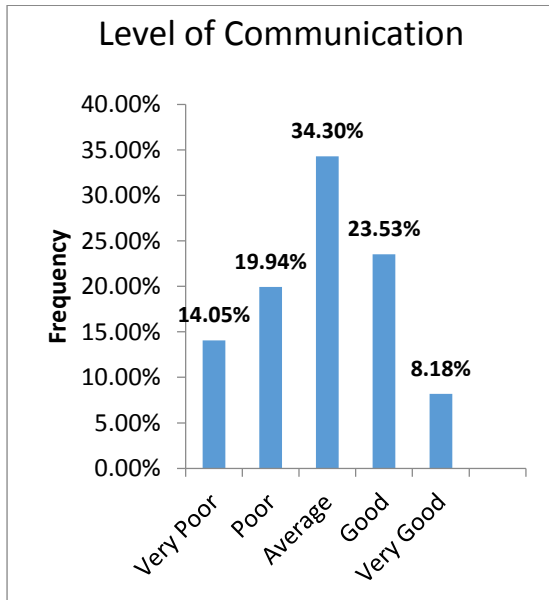


The students were asked about the various teaching modes used to teach them by their respective teachers. The students listed all the

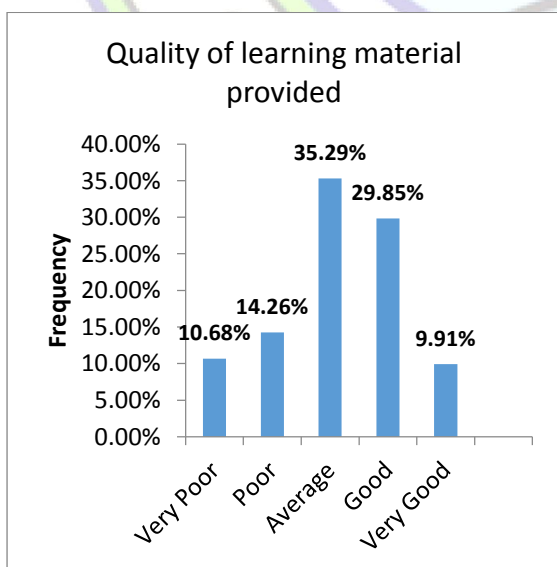
Majority students (over 70%) have placed the efforts put in by teachers to teach in online mode from average to very good. Out of these students over 56% have placed the level of

effort invested by teacher in good and very good category.

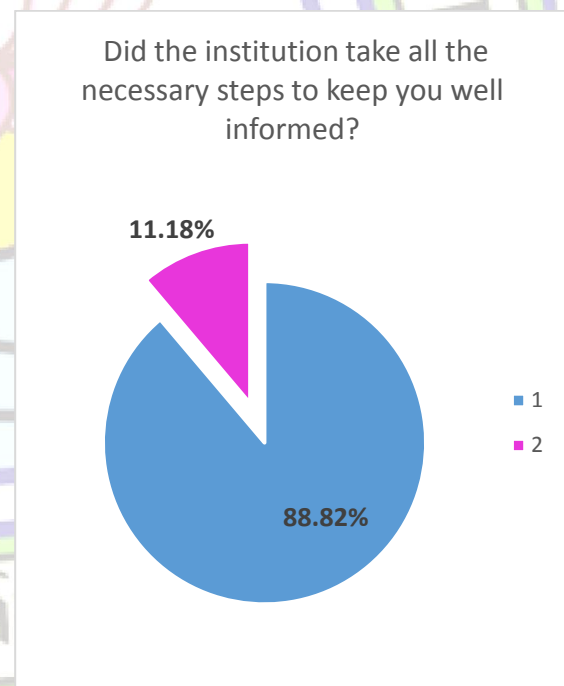
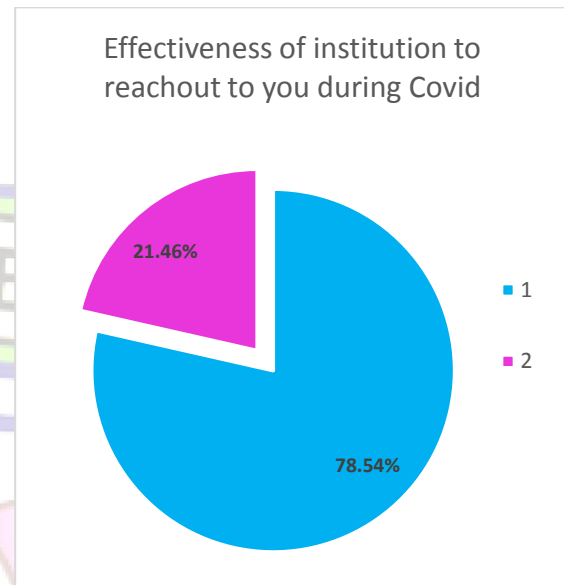

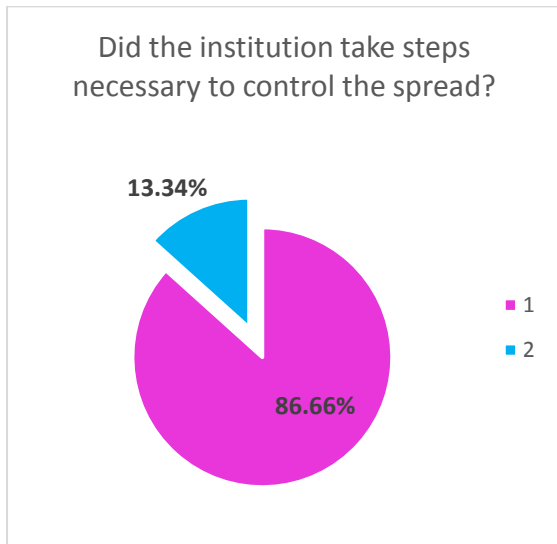
The students were asked to express their opinions on the quality of learning materials provided by the teacher, over 75% responses were from average to good. With around 40% responses indicating good and very good.



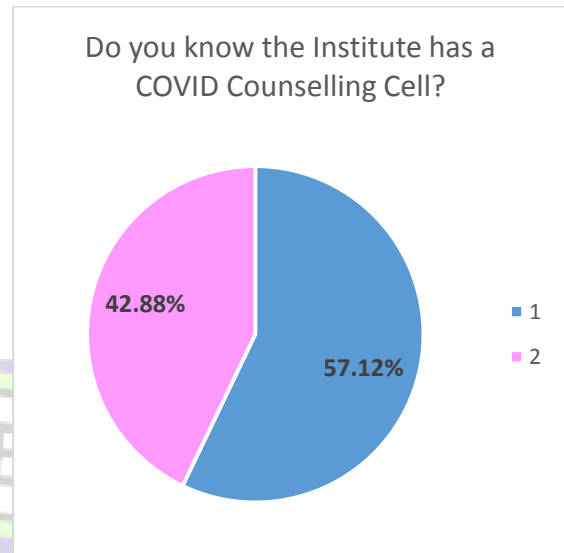
The over 78% respondents felt that the institution could reach out to them during Covid times effectively. Here 1, represents Yes and 2 represents no.



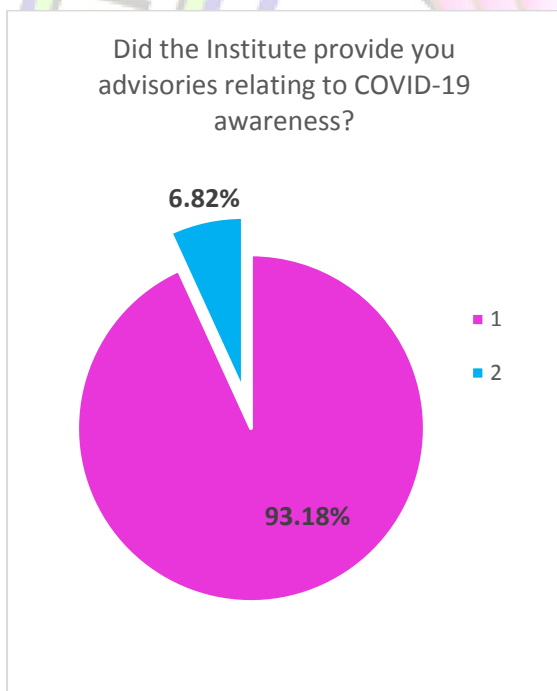
Over 88% students feel that the institution took all the necessary steps to keep them well informed. Here 1, represents yes as a response and 2 for no.



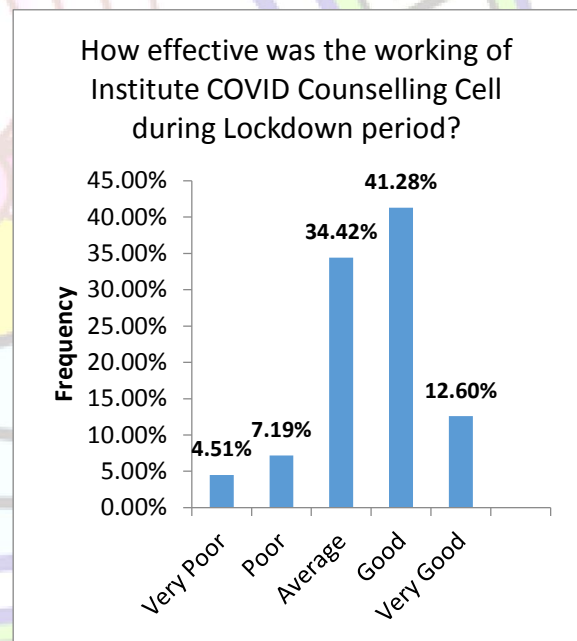

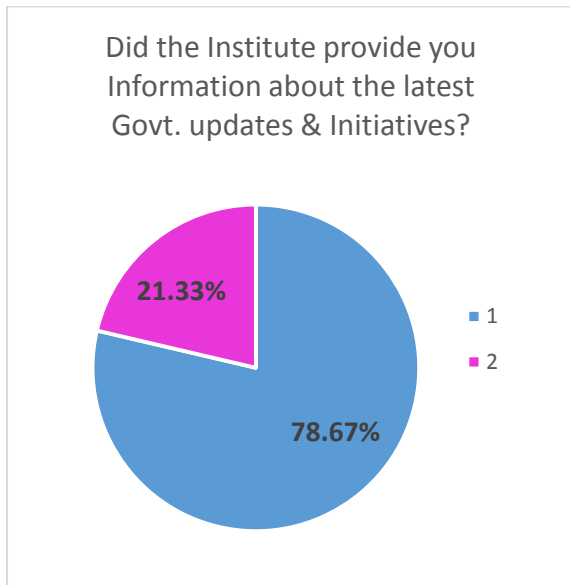
Majority of the students were aware about the COVID counselling cell. Here also, 1 represents the responses recorded as yes and 2 stands for those who responded no.



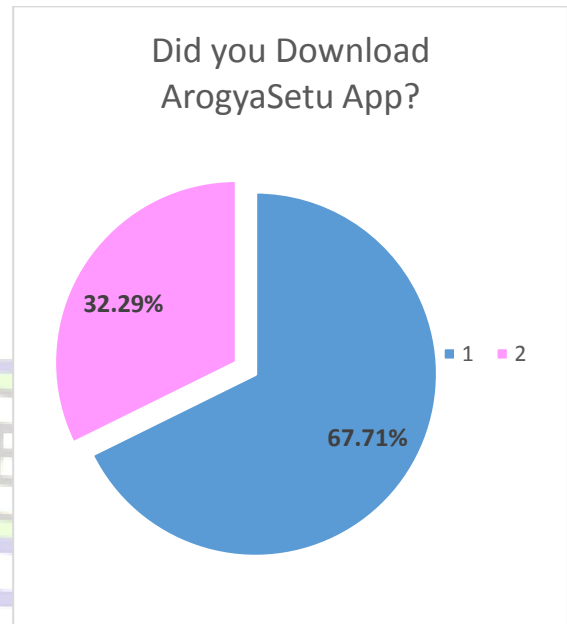
Over 93% students testify that the institution has been providing them with advisories relating to Covid-19. Here again, 1 is for the responses recorded yes and 2 for no.



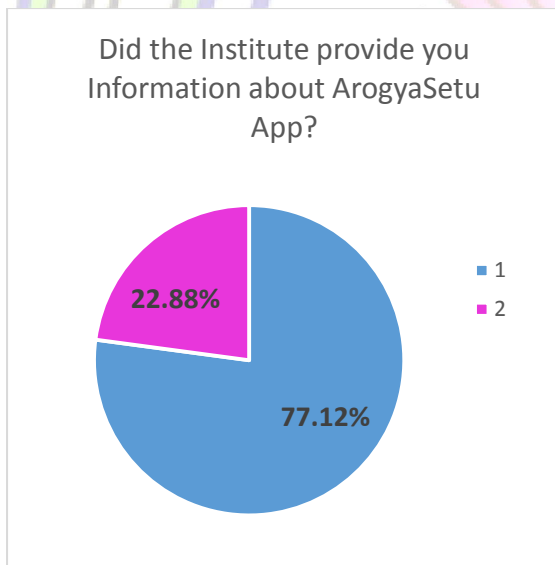
Over 50% students have rated the effectiveness of working of COVID Counselling Cell as good and very good.
