

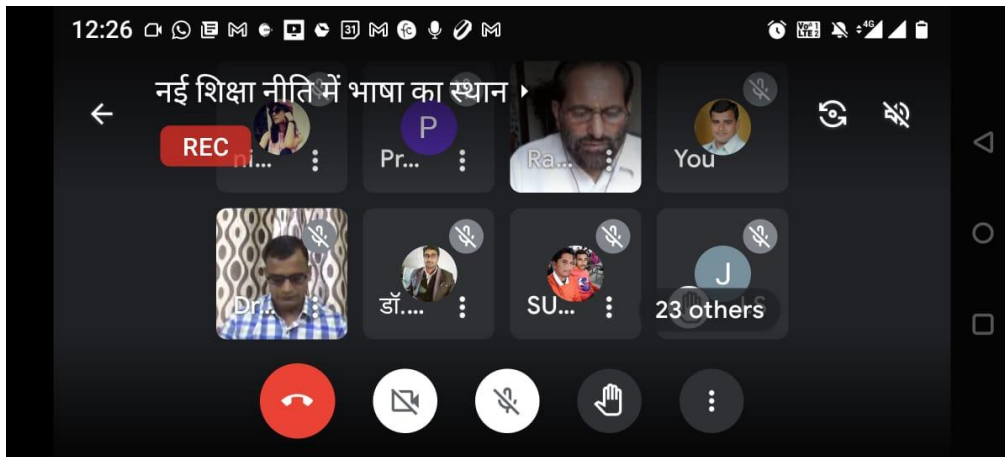


## Webinar on Place of Language in New National Education Policy

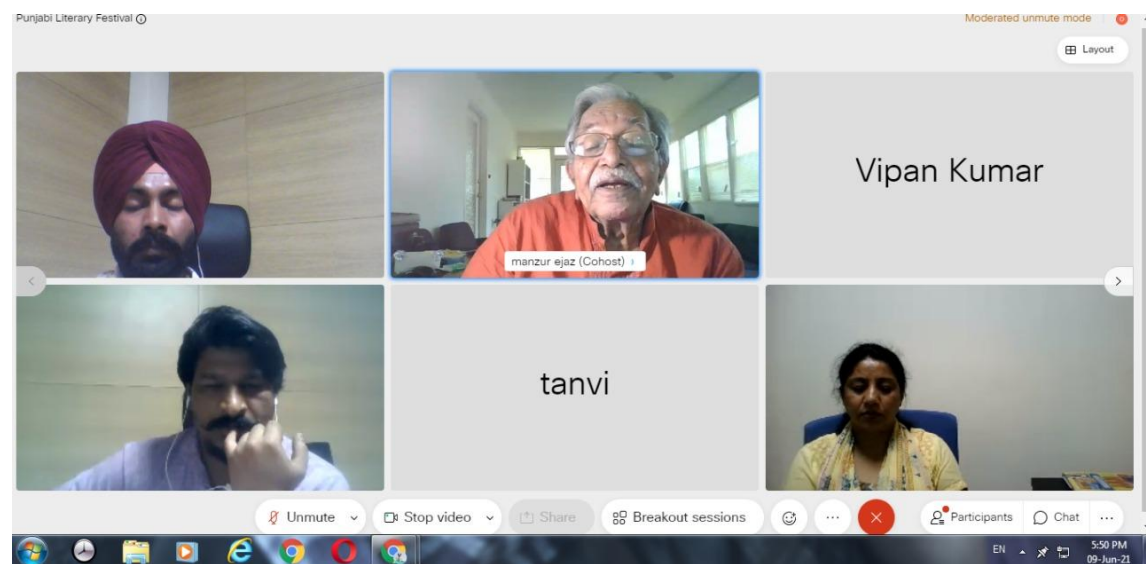

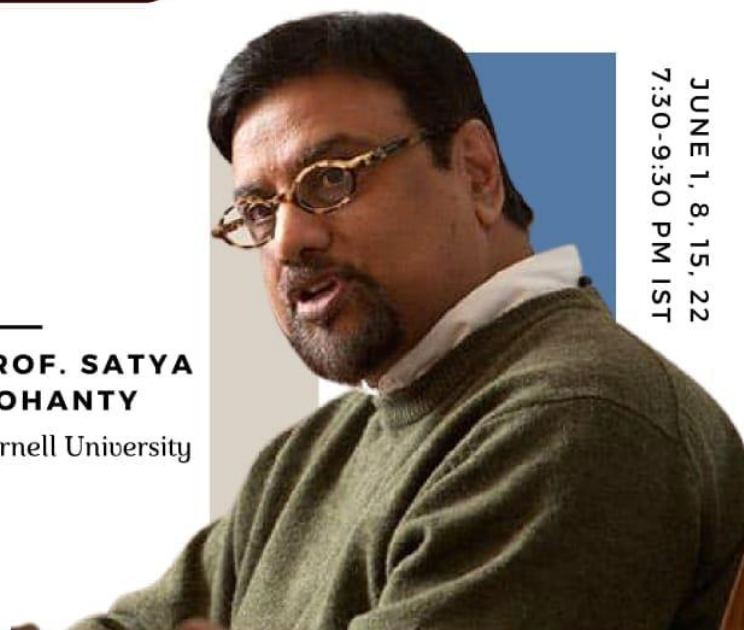

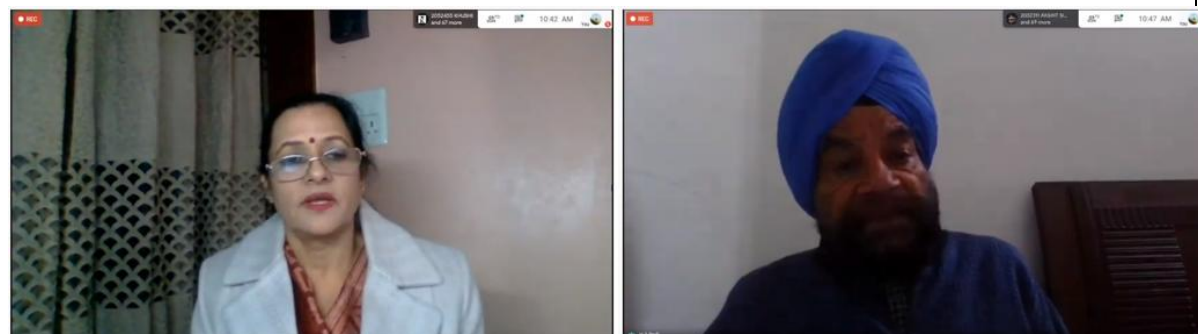


### Webinar on Changes in Indian Culture and Literature due to Western Influence

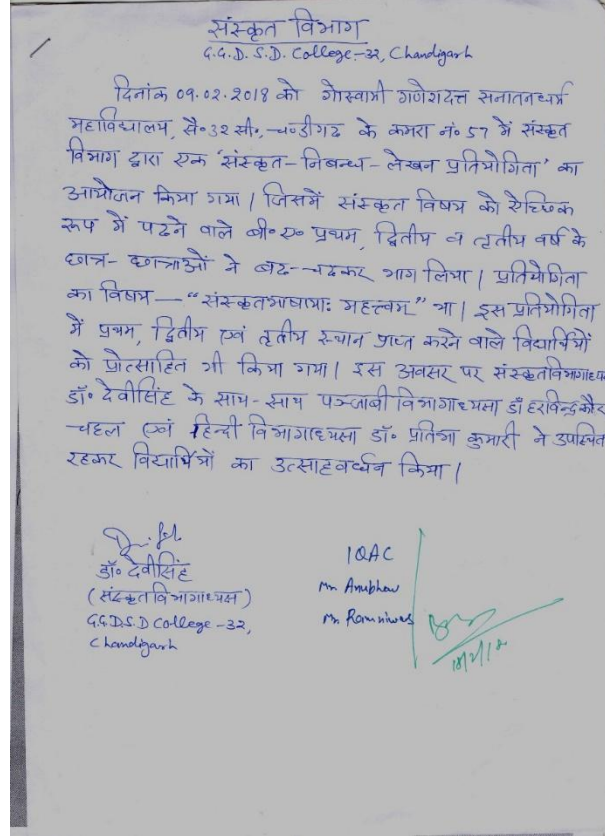


## Essay writing on Significance of Sanskrit Language

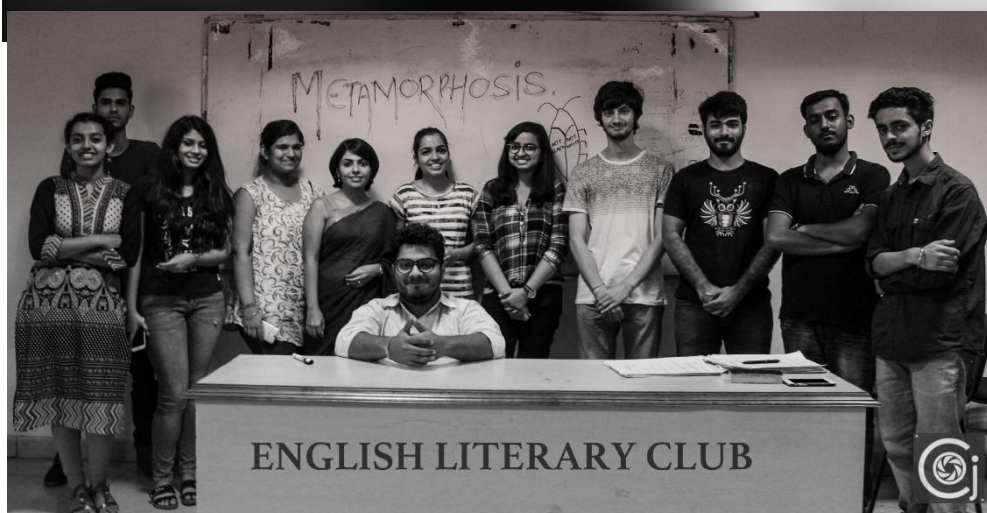

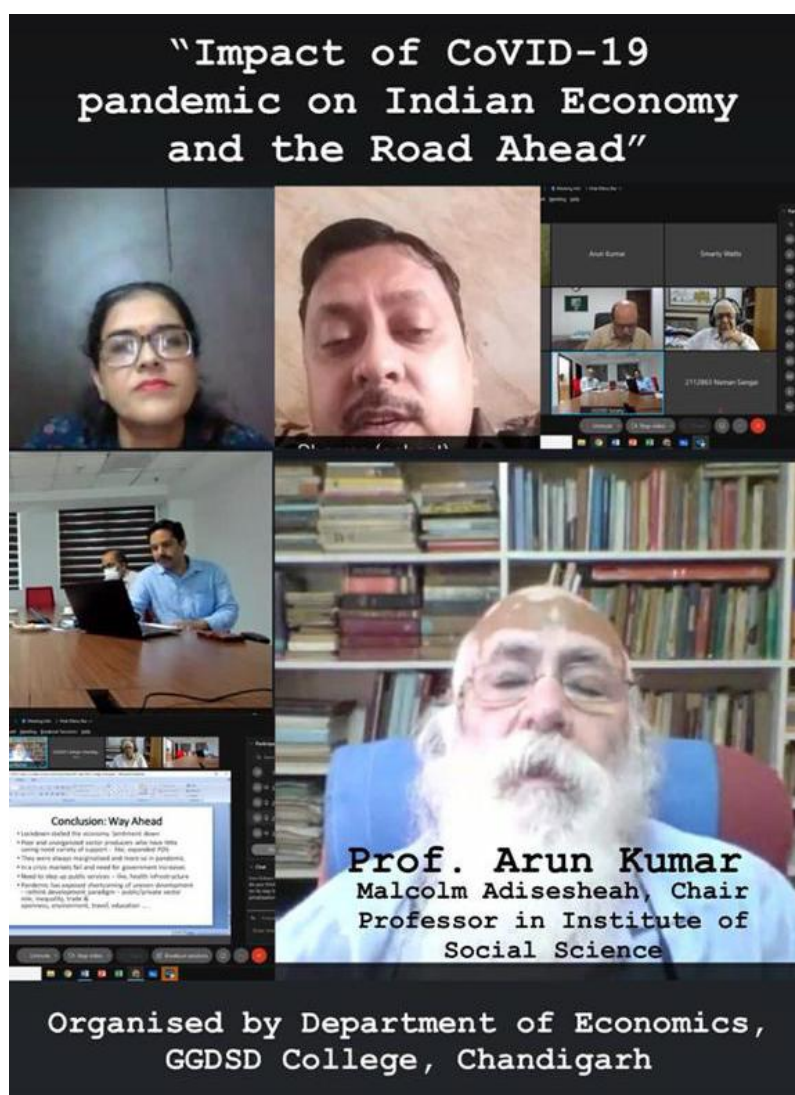

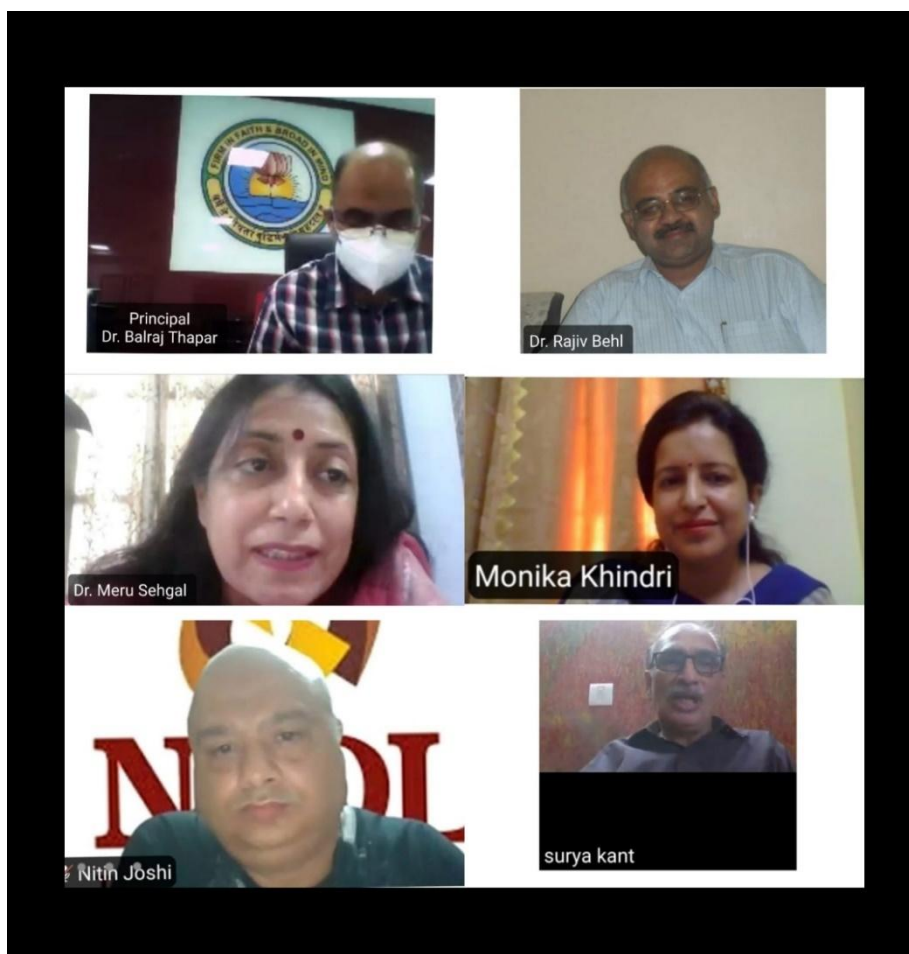


## Webinar on Financial Awareness: A Key to Financial Well-Being

She explained that how plasma theory facilitates other fields such as high energy physics and at last she winded up with the impacts of plasma theory on society and its benefits. **Dr. Nitin Kumar**, IIT Bombay continued with explanation of controlling and tuning active material. **Prof. Ravi Kumar**, NIT Hamirpur emphasized on the p-type transparent conducting oxide materials. **Dr. Ashish Arora**, University of Münster, Germany threw light on the experiments on semiconductors using light and strong magnetic fields.

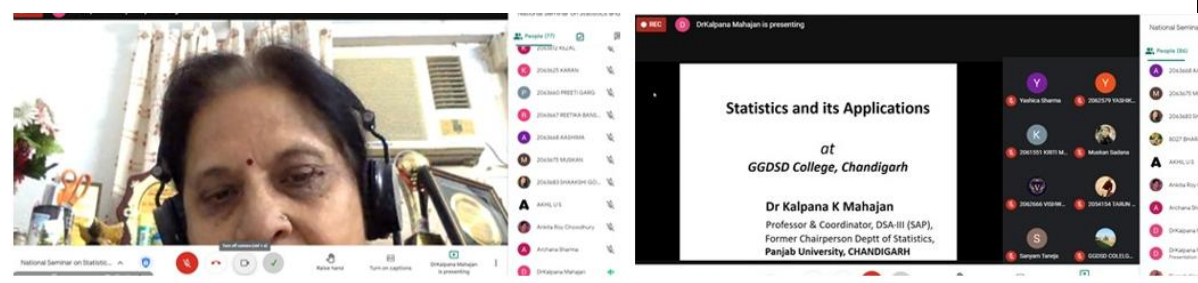


### Webinar on Statistics and its Applications

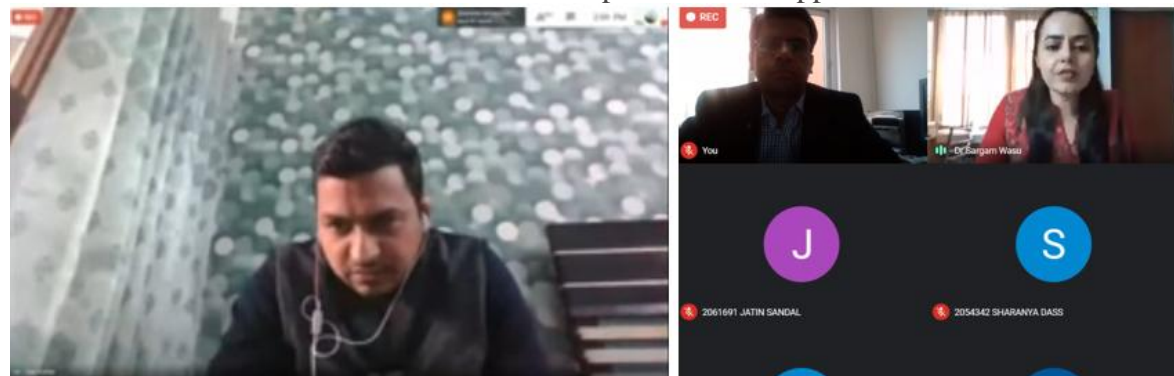


### Webinar on Numbers: Fun & Facts

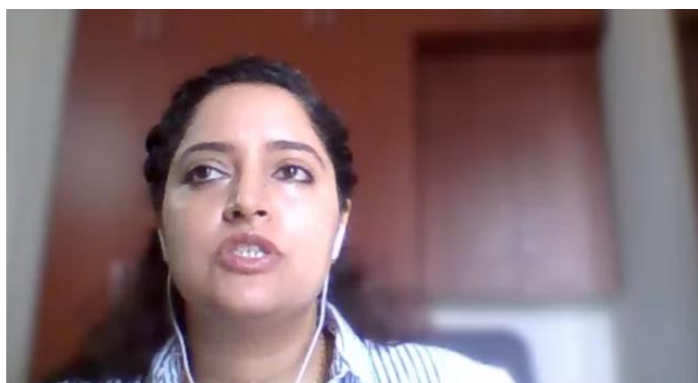


### Webinar on Impact of biotechnology advances in crop improvement

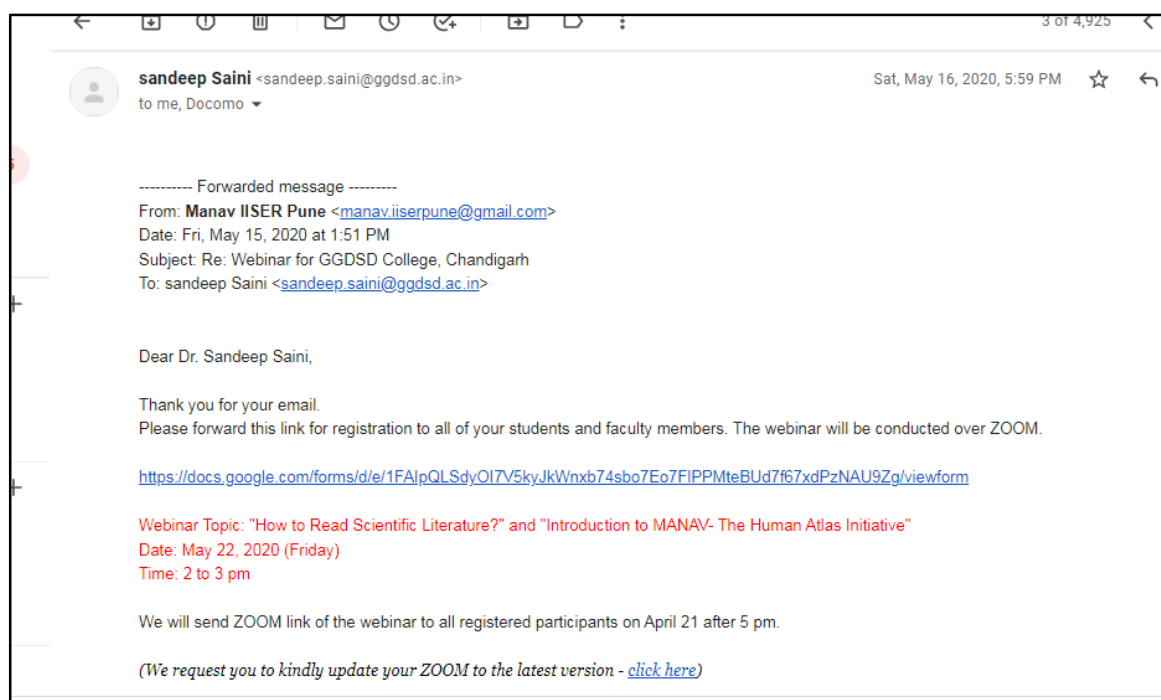
