The college has renewed its license with TCSION ERP Solution Software. The college is using the online admission, online fee deposit, online student and faculty attendance, and leave system, online faculty payroll, online hostel management and online digital learning platform.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college is continuously evolving according to the needs of changing time. The Management of the college is supporting a healthy and green development, which is indicated through the kind of growth happening in the college. To meet the growing needs of the students and adopt the changing curriculum, modifications to the existing infrastructure are made from time to time. The college is planning to launch new courses in the new academic session and to meet its requirements, a new building with the latest technology support has been constructed. The long pending demand for expansion of parking space for the rising number of faculty members has been met in this financial year. Every year, several functions with a footfall of more than six thousand students were being organized on a temporary stage. But this year, the college has a permanent open stage besides the main auditorium.

LIBRARY

G.G.D.S.D. College Library is a state-of-the-art academic library in the region, with a long-standing reputation for technological innovation and excellence in customer service. The scholarly ambience and the co-operative library staff encourage students to spend as much time as possible amidst the soothing company of books. At present, the physical collection of the library includes 69,448 books, 3,495 CDs/DVDs, 110 journals and magazines, and 22 newspapers. Digital collection of the library includes 35,000 e-books and 6,000+ e-journals through **INFLIBNET N-List Programme and National Digital Library of India**. New resources are added to the collection every year to ensure staff and students have access to the latest quality resources for teaching, research, and study. The online resources subscribed to by the Library are accessible to staff and students (using passwords) anytime, anywhere. Students can give feedback regarding Library services and resources through Online Feedback Form from college website.

Centralized Research Facility cum Digital Library has 15 i5 computers for students, and 10 i7 computers for staff to access e-resources, e-contents, CMIE ProwessIQ Database, Statistical Software like Minitab and SPSS. The library is automated with integrated ERP software named TCSION.JAWS: screen reading software for facilitating visually impaired students has also been installed on two computers. The Reader's Club of the library holds activities from time to time to acquaint users to promote reading habits.

Information Services like OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue), Reprographic Service, ILL (Inter Library Loan), Internet Surfing, Current Content Alert, SMS Alert Services, Previous Year Question Papers Alert, Employment News, and New Arrival Books are provided to the users of the library. The library staff conducts user orientation programmes to familiarize the users with library collection and resources.
