






1.4 TEACHERS' FEEDBACK REPORT 2018-19


The feedback has been collected from 101 respondents (faculty members) for the session 2018-19. The results are as follows:




Majority of the respondents either agree or strongly agree that the syllabus is suitable to the course.

Around 45 percent of respondents agree and nearing 22 percent strongly agree that there are sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the library.




Over 50 percent of the respondents agree and nearing 13 percent strongly agree that the books prescribed/listed as reference material are relevant, updated and appropriate.






1.4 TEACHERS' FEEDBACK REPORT 2018-19

The 39.60% respondents agree to the examination system followed for student evaluation. But 33.66% hold a neutral opinion. 12.87% strongly agree to it.




Over three fourth of the respondents either agree or strongly agree that they have freedom to adopt newer teaching pedagogy.








Over three fourth of the respondents either agree or strongly agree that the environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research.

Around 59 percent of the respondents agree or strongly agree to the afore mentioned statement.







