

1.4 Alumni Feedback Report 2020-21


The following feedback was received from the alumni of our college for the session 2020-21:




The alumni of the college have rated the content of the syllabi between good and excellent (nearing 85 percent).


Similar feedback has been received with respect to the syllabus being need based i.e. over 55 percent of our respondents agree or strongly agree to the fact.

Over 50 percent of the respondents either agree or strongly agree that the programme outcomes are well defined.












Around 48 percent respondents agree and strongly agree that the curriculum is balanced with respect to theory and practical. Where, 20 percent of respondents held a neutral stand.

Over 40 percent of respondents agree and strongly agree that curriculum is up to their expectations. But a good number holds a neutral stand on this issue (29.19 percent).

The neutral stand as discussed in the above question has been validated by the fact that around 30 percent of the respondents are not sure if the curriculum needs improvement. But there are others who believe the curriculum needs improvement (57 percent).


Curriculumn is upto your expectation








Curriculumn needs improvement



Teaching plan shared






A teaching plan was share with majority respondents, i.e. around 70 percent of the respondents responded in yes for the same.

 $59\ percent$ respondents testified that the feedback of assessments were shared with them.


On an average around 77.75 percent syllabus was covered in class.

Assignments given to students






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
Oppurtunities provided for participation in seminars, webinars etc.


Nearly, three fourth of our respondents, our alumni have graded their overall learning experience in the college as either good or excellent.








Grade your overall learning experience




Overall Rating of the college
