A session on '**Yoga for Peace**' was organised by the NSS unit of the College for the students, faculty and staff, in the College premises on 29 May.

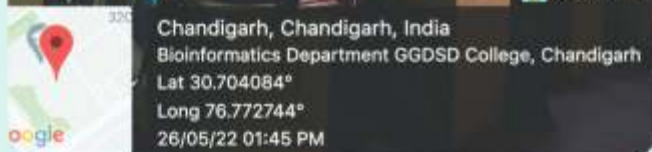

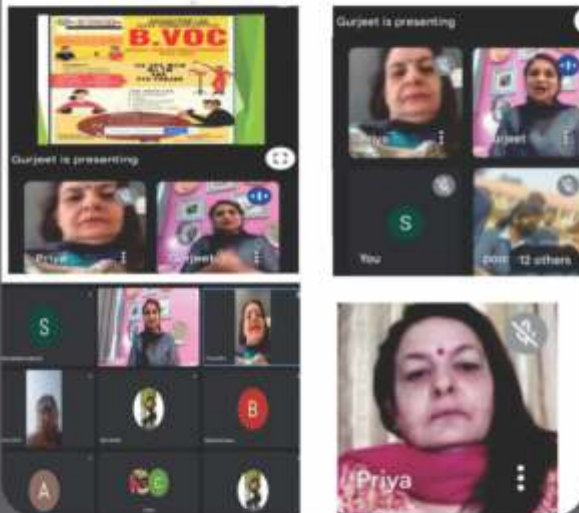
An inter-college **RJ Hunt Contest** was organised by the Postgraduate Department of Mass Communication where winners got the chance to record their own program at the Department's radio studio.
