

1.4 Students' Feedback Report 2021-22




Student feedback was collected using a google form for the academic session 2021-22. In all 840 existing students filled the google form and the responses received have been presented below.


Are you satisfied by the mode being used?



Majority of the respondents were satisfied with the mode of teaching, a little above 80 percent. They found clarity in communication during lectures nearing 43 percent rated it good and a little above 17 stated it very good. Nearing 70 percent respondents were satisfied with the contents of the curriculum taught during 2021-22.



Are you satisfied with the contents of the curricilum / syllabus taught during the academic session 2021-22?








Clarity of communication during the lectures.




Has the curriculum enhanced your

The syllabus was completed on time during the session.




The syllabus is satisfactorily designed to enhance the employability of the students.




Latest trends and advancements are satisfactorily upgraded and added in the curriculum.



Sufficient books and reference material are available for the topics mentioned in the curriculum in college library





The college has sufficient ICT facilities / learning resources and infrastructure.




35.95 percent of respondents agree and 10.71 percent strongly agree that addition of latest trends in curriculum has been made. 52.86 percent and 19.29 percent agree and strongly agree that sufficient books and reference material are available for topics mentioned in curriculum in college library. 50 percent agree and 15.60 percent strongly agree that the that college provides for adequate ICT facilities/ learning resources and infrastructure.

Around 43 percent respondents agree and around 18 percent strongly agree that they are satisfied with the co-curricular activities organsied by

the different clubs of the college. 39.29 percent agree and 10.83 percent strongly agree that they are satisfied with the career guidance and mentoring provided during the academic session.

An open-ended question with respect to suggestions regarding addition or deletion in syllabus was asked to which the major recommendation which were received are as follows:

- 1. Introduction of new software in IT courses which are more relevant to the market needs today
- 2. The syllabus should be balanced with respect to theory and practical content
- 3. Newer research tools and software should be incorporated in syllabus
- 4. The undergraduate syllabus should include topics which are in alignment with master's programme (in India and abroad)
