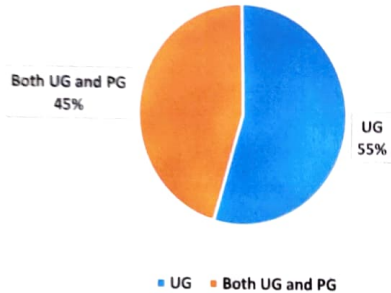

1.4 Teachers' Feedback Report 2021-22

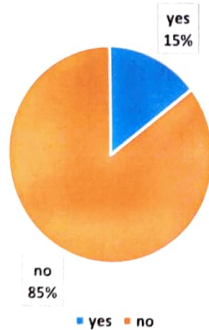


Feedback was submitted by 110 teachers for the academic session 2021-22 using a google form. The following responses have been received:

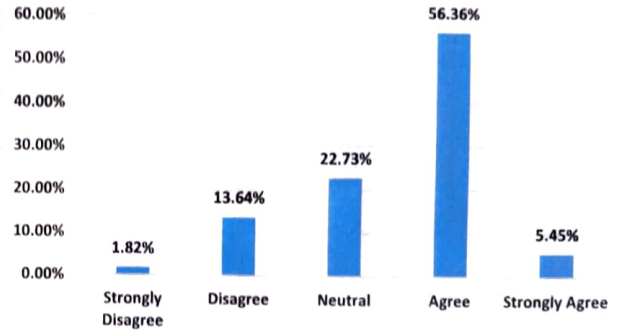
Current class of teaching

Current syllabus is need based



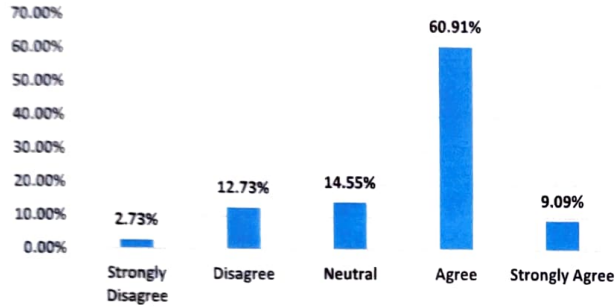
55 percent of faculty members are engaged in teaching of UG courses alone where as 45 percent teach both UG and PG courses.

15 percent of our faculty members were a member of board of studies during the session.

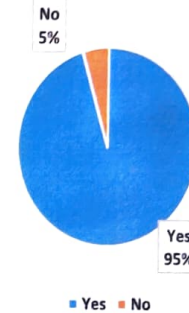
56.36 percent faculty members agree that the syllabus is need based.



Curriculum is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge



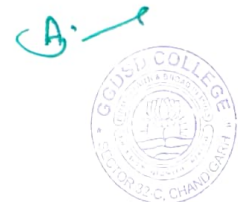
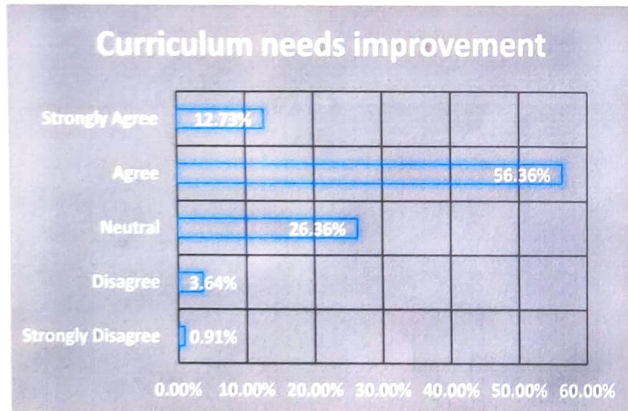
Teaching Plan prepared and disseminated to students



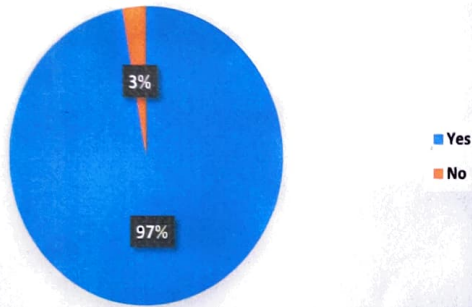
Over 60 percent of the faculty members agree that the syllabus is balanced with regard to theoretical and practical knowledge.

56.36 percent faculty members agree and 12.73 strongly agree that the curriculum needs improvement.

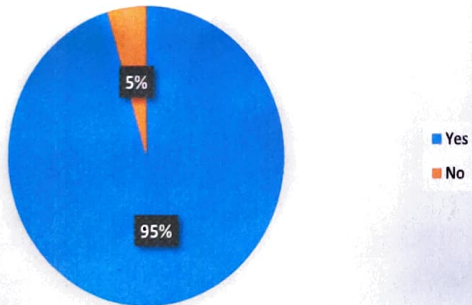
95 percent faculty members prepare and disseminate teaching plans to students



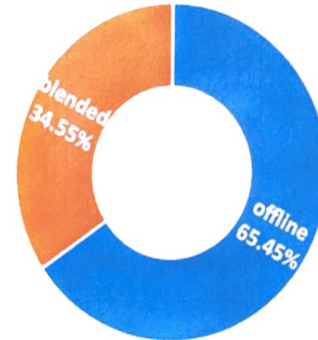
Assignments given to students

Preferred mode of teaching

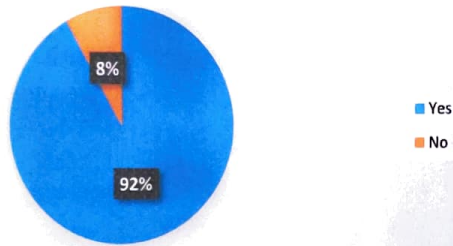


97 percent of the faculty members give assignments to the students and 95 percent amongst them share the feedback for the same with their students.

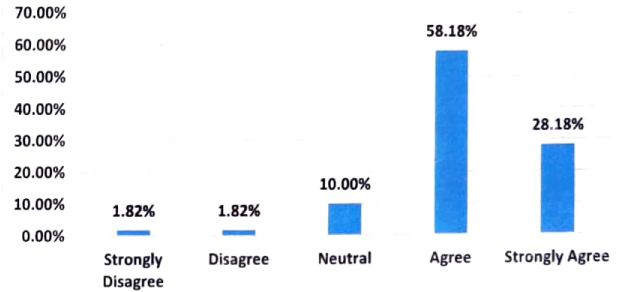
65.45 percent faculty members prefer offline mode of teaching whereas 34.55 percent prefer blended mode of teaching.



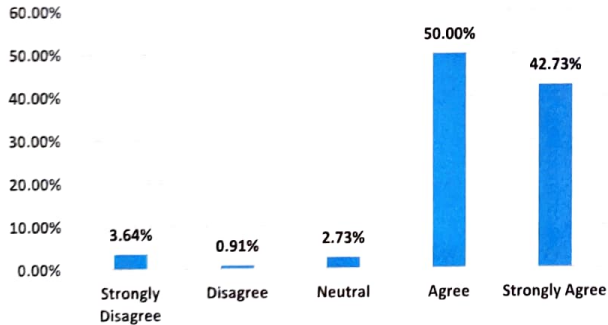
Attended Faculty enrichment programmes/Seminars/Workshops for knowledge updation



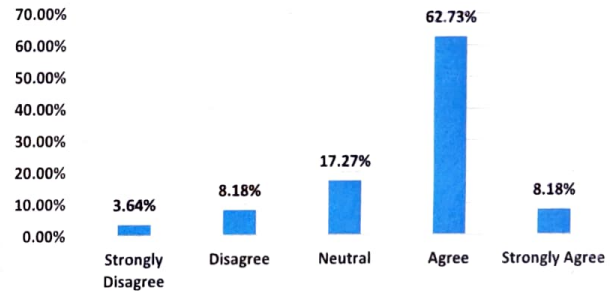
Computer facilities are made available for ICT based teaching to the teachers

Various methods of teaching were used by the faculty including lecturing, power point presentations, group discussions, case studies etc.

92 percent faculty members attended faculty enrichment programme/Workshops/Seminars for knowledge updation.

50 percent agree and 42.73 strongly agree that the library is well equipped and accessible.

58.18 and 28.18 percent faculty members agree and strongly agree respectively with the availability of computer and ICT facilities for the faculty members

62.78 percent agree and 8.18 percent strongly agree that there is a mechanism for feedback, review and performance for the staff.

The general recommendations made by the faculty members were largely with respect to the alignment of syllabus with market needs (employability) and global trends (in academic world).
