Q1. Which Courses are available at GGDSD College Chandigarh? Ans1.

Q2. What is Centralized Admission? For what courses is it applicable?

Ans2. Admission through DHE, Chandigarh for some courses are called Centralized Admission Process. Applicants seeking admission to B.Com-1st, BBA-1st, BCA-1st, B.Sc-1st (Med/Non-Med), B.Sc. (Hons) Biotechnology-1st & B.Sc. (Hons) Bioinformatics-1st courses need to go through this process. Kindly follow <u>DHE Website</u> for instructions.

Q3. What is the difference between Centralized and Non-Centralized admission?

Ans3. Centralized admission are done through the DHE portal for all the colleges and Non-centralized admissions are done at the college level. The courses for which centralized admission is done are as follows: B.B.A.-I/ B.C.A.-I/ B.Com.-I/ B.Sc.-I (Non-Medical and Medical – All Courses) / B.Sc. Biotechnology - I (Hons.) / B.Sc. Bioinformatics -I (Hons.).

Admission to the courses such as Bachelor of Arts-I, M.A.(English/Economics/Sociology), M.Com./ M.Com (EFB), M.Sc (Physics/ Biotechnology/ Bioinformatics/Chemistry (Pharmaceuticals)/Information Technology & PG Diplomas, B.Voc-1st and all ongoing classes will be done at the college level, such admission are called Non-Centralized admission.

Q4. What is the process for students seeking admission in B.Com-1st, BBA-1st, BCA-1st, B.Sc-1st (Med/Non-Med), B.Sc. (Hons) Biotechnology-1st & B.Sc. (Hons) Bioinformatics-1st year?

Ans4. For all centralized courses such as B.Com-1st, BBA-1st, BCA-1st, B.Sc-1st (Med/Non-Med), B.Sc. (Hons) Biotechnology-1st & B.Sc. (Hons) Bioinformatics-1st year, kindly check the website of Department of Higher Education i.e. www.dhe.chd.gov.in

O5. Is there any entrance test for centralized admission?

Ans5. There is no entrance test for centralized admissions in various colleges of Chandigarh. The admission will be done on the basis of marks obtained in last qualifying exam.

Q6. What is the process for students seeking admission in BA-1st and B.Voc-1st year?

Ans6. Applicant seeking admission to BA-1st and B.Voc-1st year, should visit the college website i.e. www.ggdsd.ac.in

Q7. What is the process for students seeking admission to PG and PG Diploma Courses?

Ans7. Admission for the PG Course and PG Diploma Courses can be done at College Level Only, Kindly check college website i.e. www.ggdsd.ac.in regularly.

Q8. What is the process for students seeking admission through the UT Pool?

Ans8. To avail the UT Pool applicants must submit the proof of having completed 10+2 from schools situated in Chandigarh. 85% seats are reserved for the UT Pool.

Q9. Who would be eligible for the General Pool?

Ans9. Candidates who have not studied 10+2 at Chandigarh are eligible for General Pool. 15% seats are reserved for General Pool students (outside Chandigarh).

Q10. What would be the mode of payment (online filling e-form)?

Ans10. For making payment: there is only online mode of payment:

Online/Debit/Credit Card/Net banking/Wallets/UPI

Q11. What is the criteria of allocation of seats in various courses?

Ans11. The seat allocation in all the courses strictly on the basis of merit as per the reservation policy by the UT Administration, Chandigarh/Panjab University.

O12. Where will the merit list be made available on the website?

Ans12. Merit list will be available at college website (www.ggdsd.ac.in) for Non-Centralized Courses and merit list for Centralized Admission will be available on DHE website (i.e. www.dhe.chd.gov.in)

Q13. When can Honours students choose Honours subject?

Ans13. For Honours Subject in the old system, a student can apply for Honours subject in 3rd Semester. (**After taking admission is 3rd semester).** In case, the Panjab University enforces CBCS, the honours subject can be opted from 1st semester onwards.

Q14. Where should an applicant go for counseling at the time of Admission?

Ans14. Counseling will be held online or as per directions of DHE/Panjab University, Chandigarh for centralized courses. Please keep checking DHE website regularly and for non-centralized courses keep checking college website regularly.

Q15. What reservation rules apply for admission in any program?

Ans15. All reservations benefits would be given as per State Government policies and Panjab University guidelines.

Q16. I have paid the Application Fee and the amount has been deducted from my Bank Account but the Payment Status has not been updated yet; what should I do?

Ans16. Candidates who have successfully paid the Application Fee and the amount has been deducted from their Bank Account should not attempt to pay the Fee again. Contact fee@ggdsd.ac.in for queries.

Q17: I don't have methods of online fee payment; can I submit the Application Fee offline and submit its receipt at the campus?

Ans17. Sorry, there is no provision for offline payment of Application fee.

Q18: What are the conditions for gap year students while applying for admission?

Ans18. If there is gap in taking admission after Intermediate or Graduation, then an affidavit certified by the Notary on Stamp paper has to be submitted at the time of admission.

Q19: Where can I see the status of allotment of seats?

Ans19. The details of allotment of seats shall be displayed as per the schedule given in the Joint Prospectus on www.dhe.chd.gov.in in case of Centralized Admission and in case of non-centralized admissions, schedule will be displayed on www.ggdsd.ac.in.

Q20. How do I get Sports Quota Seat?

Ans20. Sports Quota seat for admission to B.Com-1st, BBA-1st, BCA-1st, B.Sc-1st (Med/Non-Med), B.Sc. (Hons) Biotechnology-1st & B.Sc. (Hons) Bioinformatics-1st (**CENTRALIZED ADMISSION**) will be given to the candidates having sports gradation certificate issued by Sports Department Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh only. Gradation certificate issued from any other state will not be considered.

For Non-Centralized courses (BA-1st, B.Voc-1st, PG Courses and PG Diploma, etc.) visit Department of Physical Education of the College.

Q21. What is the procedure for seeking admission in the 3rd semester?

Ans21. For seeking Admission in **3rd Semester:**

- i) For New Applicant (Non Existing College Student), kindly fill form as New Applicant on College Website.
- ii) For Old Student, Kindly fill form as Old Student on College Website.

 While uploading document, Applicant/Student can upload latest result either of 1st SEM or of 2nd SEM (whichever is later).

Q22. What is the procedure for seeking admission in the 5th semester?

Ans22. For seeking Admission in **5th Semester:**

- i) For **New Applicant** (Non Existing College Student) kindly fill form as New Applicant on College Website.
- ii) For Old Student kindly fill form as Old Student on College Website.

For Uploading documents Applicant/Student can upload latest result either of 3rd Semester or of 4th Semester (whichever is later).
