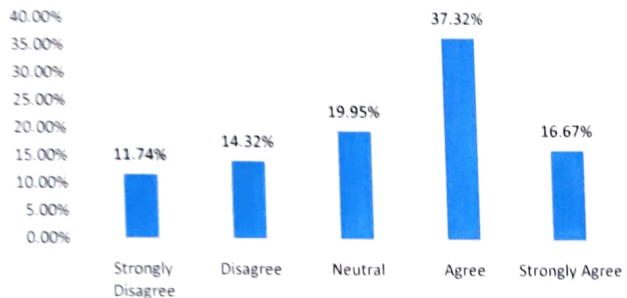


**Alumni Feedback Report

Syllabus was satisfactorily designed to enhance the employability of the students

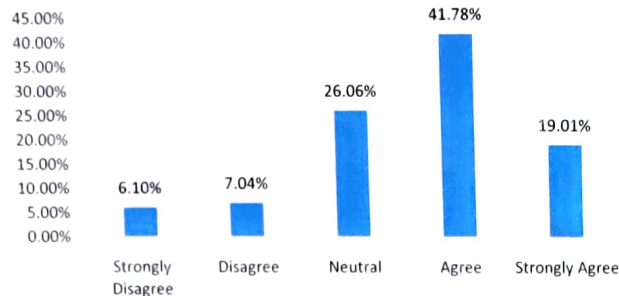


According to the survey, majority of the respondents either agree or strongly agree that syllabus was satisfactorily designed to enhance the employability of the students.

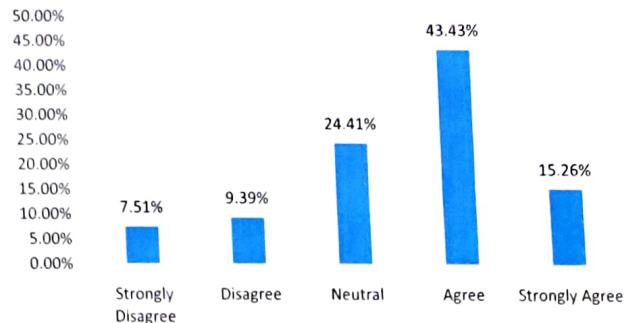
A similar result was found on being asked if curriculum enhanced their knowledge/skills/capabilities. Majority of the students either agree or strongly agree to it.

Mostly respondents either agree or strongly agree that the programme outcomes were well defined

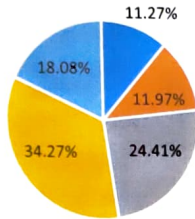
Curriculum has enhanced your knowledge / skills / capabilities

The latest trends and advancements upgraded and added in the curriculum proved to be advantageous



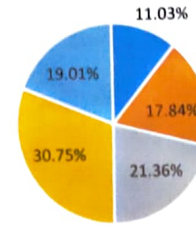

Around fifty percent respondents either agree or strongly agree that the career guidance and mentoring provided in college proved useful.

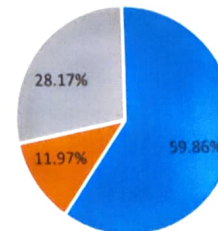
Nearing 60 percent of the respondents believe that the curriculum needs improvement.

■ Strongly Disagree ■ Disagree ■ Neutral ■ Agree ■ Strongly Agree

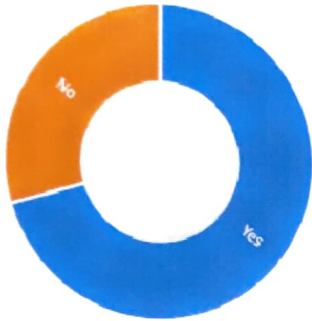
Curriculum needs improvement



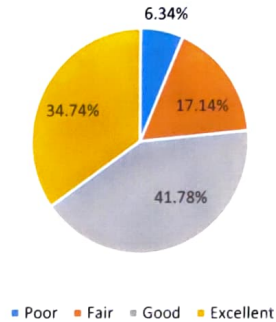

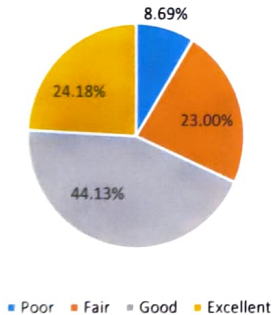
Opportunity given for participation in extra-curricular/sports activities

Grade your overall learning experience



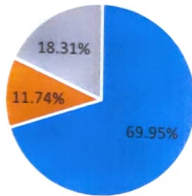
Majority of the respondents responded in affirmation that opportunities were given for participation in extra-curricular/sport activities.

A little over sixty eight percent respondents either graded the overall learning experience as either good or excellent.

Nearing forty two percent rated the college as good and nearing thirty five percent rated it as excellent. Collectively over seventy six percent respondents rated the college as good or excellent.
