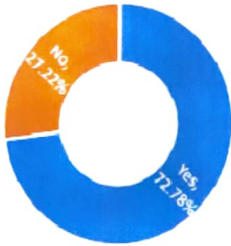


Students' Feedback Report

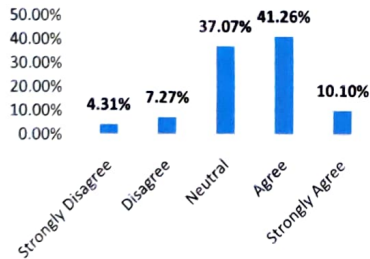

In total of 812 existing students filled in the feedback form and the following was found:

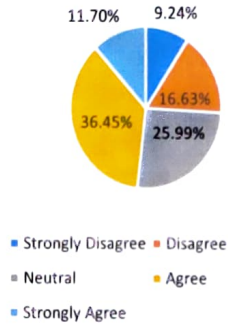
Are you satisfied with the contents of the curriculum / syllabus taught

Majority of students were satisfied with the contents of the syllabus.

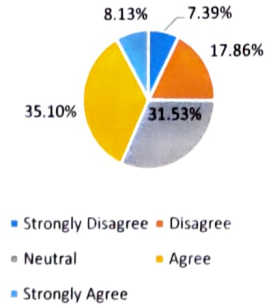
A little over 41 percent agree and 10 percent strongly agree that curriculum has enhanced their knowledge/skills/capabilities.

Nearing 12 percent strongly agree and a little over 36 percent agree that there was timely completion of the syllabus.

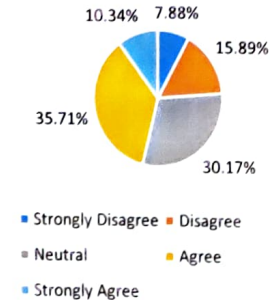
Nearing 35 and 8 percent agree and strongly agree that the syllabus was designed to enhance employability of students.

Nearing 36 percent agree and 10 percent strongly agree that latest trends and advancements are added to the syllabus

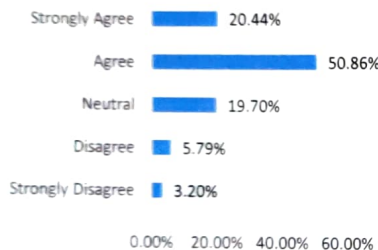
The syllabus is satisfactorily designed to enhance the employability of the students



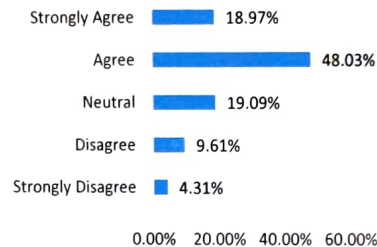
Latest trends and advancements are satisfactorily upgraded and added in the curriculum

Are you satisfied with the co-curricular activities organised by the different clubs of the college?

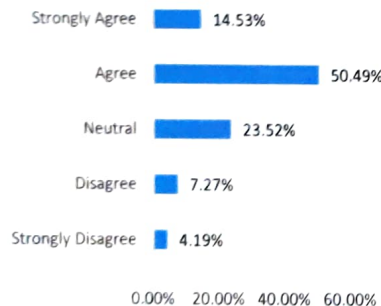


Over seventy percent respondents either agree or strongly agree that sufficient books and reference material are available for the topics mentioned in the curriculum in college library.

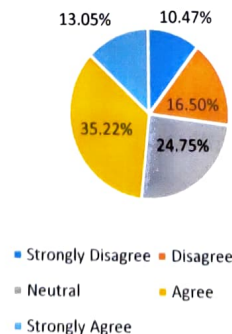
Sixty five percent respondents either agree or strongly agree that the college has sufficient ICT facilities / learning resources and infrastructure.
