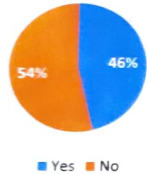

A google form was circulated amongst the faculty members and the following responses were received:

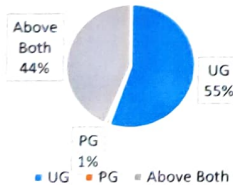
PhD degree holder

A little over 2 percent of the staff members were a member of board of studies during the academic year 2022-23.

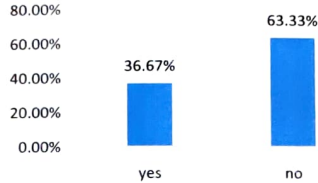
Classes taught



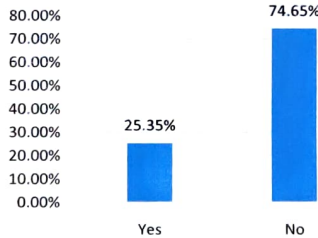
55 percent of faculty members teach UG classes alone and 44 percent teach both UG and PG. Only 1 percent teach PG alone.

Majority of the faculty members have been paper evaluators as well as paper setters for the academic year 2022-23.

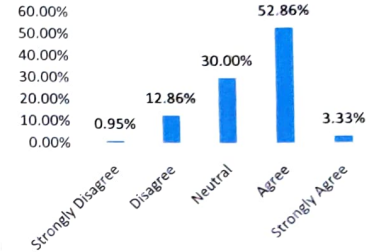
Have you been a paper evaluator for the session 2022-23



Have you been a paper setter for the session 2022-23

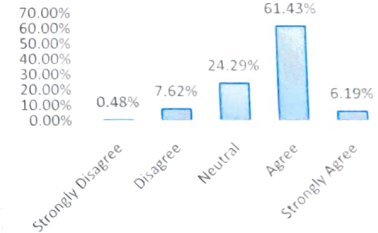


Curriculum is need based



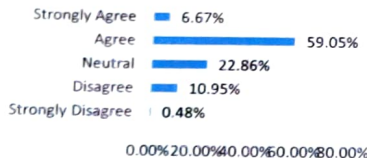
Nearing fifty three percent faculty agree and over three percent strongly agree that the curriculum is need based.

Programme outcomes of syllabi are well defined



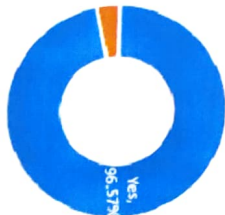
Majority of the faculty members agree and strongly agree that the programme outcomes of syllabi are well defined.

Curriculum is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge



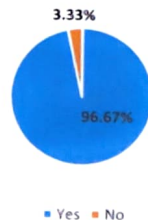
Majority of the faculty members find the curriculum balanced with respect to theoretical and practical knowledge.

Teaching plan was prepared and disseminated

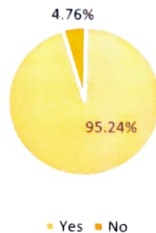


Over 96 percent faculty members disseminated teaching plan amongst students.

Assignments were given to the students

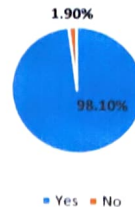


Feedback of assignment was shared with students



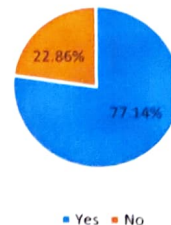
Majority of the faculty members gave assignments and shared feedback with the students.

Student performance feedback was shared with them.

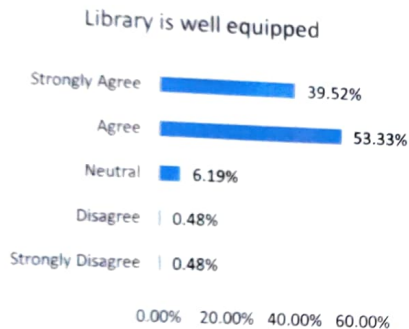
Attended Faculty enrichment programmes/Seminars etc.



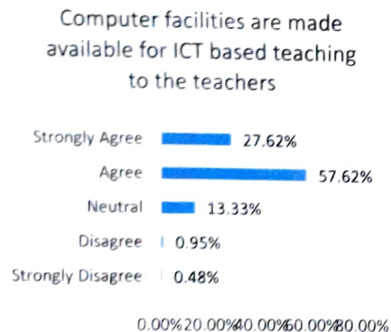
Over 77 percent faculty attended faculty enrichment programmes/ seminars.



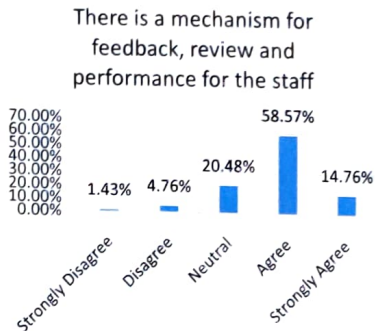
83 faculty members attended FDPs/OC/RCs in the academic year 2022-23.
