CIRCULAR

In conosnee to Right of Persons with disabilities in Academic Session 2019-20
Handbook of Information, 2019 that the following rules for a large to a large to the Person of Persons with Distibilities (RPWD) Act, 2016, it is notified in the Handbook of Information, 2019 that the following rules for admissions to be implemented in Panjab University and its affiliated regional centres/colleges:

- 1. 5% seats will be horizontally reserved for persons or class of Persons with Disability (PwD) out of which 1% each shall be reserved for persons suffering from the disabilities specified under the RPWD 2016 Act.
 - 2. Applicants under the Reserved Category of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks for calculation of merit in seeking admission to the courses in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been specified, provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by the University regulations.
 - 3. The candidate under the Reserved Category of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities shall be allowed an upper age relaxation of 5 years for admission, in the courses wherever upper age restriction is applicable.(Source:- Handbook of Informatiom 2019, Panjab University, Page 23-25 Panjab University).

In this regard, it is requested to the Chairpersons/Directors/Coordinators/Principals of all the respective Department/Centre/Cell/Colleges ensure that:

- 1. Not less than 5% seats shall be reserved and filled in respect of students with benchmark disabilities as per the RPWD Act. 2016.
- 2. Every Department Centre/Cell must prepare a separate cut off list of persons with disabilities and ensure that maximum students are accommodated as per their requirement of courses. To maintain a record of the number of candidate applying and admitted (with all contact details) in the particular course after counseling. The same · e Con u

information along with all details of the applicants should be communicated to the Equal opportunity Cell of Persons with Disabilities (EOC-PWDs).

- 3. Help desk service should be available to deal with the process of admission of students with disabilities.
- 4. Provision of volunteers should be made to assist the students with disabilities during the process of admission. The studnets with disabilities should not be charged any fee for assisting them during admission process.
- 5. The admission process of students with disabilities must be conducted at ground floor, if the such student shall not able to reach at the venue of counselling.
- 6. The Chairperson of the respective department/centre/cell must ensure that students with disabilities do not face any problem due to the non-availability of the necessary supports.
- 7. The concerned authority must provide hostel accommodation to students with disability (who need hostel accommodation) as soon as his/her admission confirmed in the respective department.
