SPECIAL NOTE: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CANDIDATES

- Candidate contesting elections must be a regular student.
- Candidate should have a minimum of 75 per cent attendance.
- The student must attach attendance sheet as downloaded from M-top (TCS).
- Candidate should not have any academic arrears in the year of contesting.
- Candidate should not have any criminal record.
- Candidate whose name has been struck off / or who has been suspended from the college will not be allowed to contest or cast vote.
- Undergraduates between the age of 17 and 22 may contest elections. This age range may be appropriately relaxed in the case of professional colleges, where course often range between 4 to 5 years.
- For Post Graduate Students the maximum age limit to legitimately contest an election would be 24-25 years.
- The contestants are required to attach original certificates 1) Date of Birth 2) DMC's of All Previous Semester Examination passed with the nomination papers.3) Attendance record as downloaded from M-top (TCS)
- Nomination for CRs must be proposed and seconded by the students of the same class only.
